Project Highlights

10,000 SF HACIENDA ESTATE

This new 10,000-square-foot home, inspired by the simple Spanish colonial style of South America, sits on an extensive ranch property at the base of Figueroa Mountain in the Santa Ynez Valley. With reclaimed-railroad-trestle-beam ceilings, hardwood floors, custom fireplace surrounds, and handcrafted metalwork, the interior has more of a sophisticated ambiance than a traditional ranch feel.

Built around a central courtyard, the home is reminiscent of an Andalusian-style hacienda. The architect picked up elements of Central America in the balconies, windows and air of formality.
